

House and Venue Rules for the LIFE BALL 2019

Event site:

City Hall of Vienna, as well as the entire City Hall Square of Vienna, and any other dedicated event areas.
Rathausplatz 1, A-1010 Vienna

Organiser:

Association LIFE+

Preamble

These house and venue rules (hereinafter: "House Rules") shall apply to the Life Ball 2019 (hereinafter: LB), organised by the association LIFE+ (hereinafter: Organiser) during the event in the event area of the LB.

These House Rules shall not apply to identified service staff of the executive, or the fire brigade or rescue services. The event area comprises the City Hall Square of Vienna and the event rooms in the City Hall of Vienna (hereinafter: LB Premises). The event rooms shall include all premises provided for events by the City Hall, including staircases, side rooms and yards.

These House Rules apply to all visitors and to Organiser, along with its employees, and the people and companies charged by Organiser. By entering the event premises, the visitor accepts the House Rules of the LB and the relevant statutory and authority provisions without reservation. The instructions of the security service/order service must be observed. Non-observance of the House Rules, instructions from the Organiser, the safety staff, or the executive shall be subject to banishment from the premises. This shall not affect any damages claims of the Organiser.

Term of effect

These House Rules shall enter into effect on 8 June 2019, 6:00 am, and shall apply until 9 June 2019, 6:00 am.

Access

During the term of application of these House Rules, only such people may be present on the LB Premises who have a corresponding accreditation (band or setup/removal card) or ticket.

The accreditation or ticket must be shown to the security or order service unprompted when entering the LB Premises and submitted to the intended validation measure. Refusal will lead to prohibition of entrance.

The following shall apply:

- Access to the City Hall Square with a ticket will commence on 8 June 2019, starting at the earliest at 4:00 pm, and to the City Hall at the earliest at 6:00 pm, depending on the ticket category. The right to access the square shall end at 0:15 am on 9 June, but at the latest at the end of the opening show. The right of access for the event in the City Hall on 8 June shall end on 9 June, 5:00 am.
- Tickets and accreditations cannot be transferred, must be carried until leaving the LB Premises and must be shown to the staff of the Organiser or the security service at any time. Any abuse of tickets/accreditations shall lead to their physical withdrawal and loss of the money paid for them, notwithstanding any further legal steps.
- Access with a press accreditation will commence at the earliest at 4:00 pm on 8 June 2019.
- Access with an employee accreditation will be according to the respective work area, and subject to separate agreement.

The specific time at which admission commences, and the end of the event, shall be disclosed by the staff of the

security service, or via announcements. After the end of the event, the guests will have half an hour to leave the LB Premises.

The accreditation (bracelet) must be attached to a wrist with the intended closing mechanism, so that it cannot be pulled over the hand. People who carry an accreditation that is not properly attached, or that has been damaged, may be banned from the LB Premises by the Organiser or the security service.

Outside of the event time, entry to, and presence on, the LB Premises or parts of them shall only be permitted with a corresponding setup/removal accreditation. During the setup/removal times, the provisions of the building coordination law (Baukoordinationsgesetz) shall apply.

The event period shall be the period from admission of the audience to the LB Premises until the end of the event. The end of the event shall be determined by the Organiser. The Organiser reserves the right to end the event prematurely for reasons of force majeure or security.

The following objects are not permitted:

- Weapons of all kinds, including any objects that can be used as weapons (e.g. sticks, rods, bottles, cans, glass containers, plastic bottles, hard packaging, etc.)
- Pyrotechnical objects: Fireworks, smoking powder, smoke bombs, etc.
- Bulky and potentially dangerous objects, such as ladders, stools, (folding) chairs, boxes, over-sized bags, backpacks, suitcases, sports bags, prams, selfie-sticks, tripods, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, umbrellas (except for walking aids),...
- Potential projectiles
- Flying drones, other flying objects (balloons, sky lanterns, etc.) remote-controlled cars and/or planes
- Gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable, drying or other dangerous substances or vessels with substances that impair health and that are easily flammable. Exception: commercial pocket lighters
- Laser pointers, torches with high lighting power
- Drugs and/or intoxicating substances
- Professional photo or video equipment
- Large amounts of paper and/or paper rolls
- Noise-makers such as megaphones, gas pressure fanfares, whistles
- Splintering or fragile objects
- Food and drink
- Animals (except for partner dogs and guide dogs).
- Advertising objects (banners, leaflets, etc.)
- Racist, xenophobic, National Socialist or party-political propaganda material

If in doubt, objects will be classified as prohibited or permitted within the meaning of these House Rules by the competent safety officer.

The Organiser reserves the right: to search people, clothes and any containers carried along for the above prohibited objects upon entry to the LB Premises.

Please note that the organiser will not take any prohibited objects found in the scope of person inspections into custody. People who refuse the control, or who carry forbidden objects, will be forbidden from entering the premises.

Attendance

People under the influence of drugs, drunk people, rowdy people and people who violate the rules of public decency, or who otherwise violate the provisions of the Viennese state security act (Wiener Landessicherheitsgesetz) or security-police act (Sicherheitspolizeigesetz) or the criminal code will not be granted access to the LB Premises or will be banned from the LB Premises.

Consuming illegal drugs or intoxicating substances on the LB Premises is strictly forbidden.

Alcohol will not be given to people who are drunk or whose behaviour may pose a risk to safety.

Vehicles

Driving and parking within the LB Premises is only permitted with a permit (well-visible car or parking card) from the Organiser. The road traffic ordinance and a speed limit of max. 10 km/h shall apply.

No smoking

Smoking prohibitions according to the provisions of the tobacco act (Tabakgesetz), as amended from time to time, must be observed at all times.

Behaviour

Everyone who enters the LB Premises:

- Must observe the orders of the Organiser, the security service and the employees of the service staff, any instructions issued through speakers (announcements) without delay. Those who wilfully or negligently do not observe these orders may be sent from the event area by the security and order service, or the staff of the service personnel.
- Must behave so that others are not injured, harmed or inconvenienced – more than is unavoidable under the circumstances.
- Must observe the contents of notice, requirement and prohibition signs on the LB Premises.
- Must not behave in any manner that causes damage or destruction to buildings, decorations, devices or other objects.
- Must report any accidents or damage to the security service or the organiser without undue delay.
- Must keep the entrances and exits, as well as the emergency, escape and rescue paths clear. Further necessary requirements may be posed from case to case to prevent or remove danger to life, health or property. The instructions issued to this end by the security and order service of the security services and the police must be observed.
- Must dispose of wastes, packaging materials and empty containers in the waste containers placed in the event area. Deliberate pollution of the event area is forbidden.
- Wheelchair users must take the places assigned to them and will be informed about the escape routes intended for them before the event starts.

Prohibitions:

- Selling or giving away tickets or goods of any kind.
- Any sales activities, including the distribution of documents and goods of all kinds, are forbidden in the direct area in front of the LB Premises and on the LB Premises without advance consent of the Organiser. Surveys and/or interview campaigns are bound to the advance consent of the Organiser. Putting up posters, distributing leaflets, etc., is forbidden in front of the entrances, on the outer faces and in the premises of the City Hall; the same applies to announcements or demonstrations.
- Entering areas that are not intended for the LB guests (backstage premises, technical areas, etc.).
- Making fire, setting off or shooting fireworks, lights, smoke powder, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnical objects.
- Stating or spreading political propaganda and actions, racist, xenophobic, radical slogans and wearing or spreading the corresponding insignia.
- Acting in any manner that others may interpret as provocative, threatening, discriminating or insulting.
- Endangering one's own life or one's own safety, or the life or safety of others or intending or causing injury or property damage at any time.
- Climbing on or over, or moving any structures and facilities not intended for this, and specifically not intended for general use, in particular, fences, walls, enclosures, barriers,

- lighting facilities, trees, masts of all kinds and roofs, or similar objects.
- Narrowing or impairing any traffic paths, entrances and exits to the visitor places and escape routes.
- Spraying, labelling, painting on or pasting on building facilities, furnishings, pillars, walls, fences or paths.
- Defecating outside of the toilets or otherwise polluting the event area.

Behaviour in case of fire

In case of fire, the security service, city-hall guards or the fire brigade must be informed at once. The instructions of the fire brigade, the authorities and the security staff must be observed. Stay calm!

Behaviour in case of danger

In case of danger (e.g. accidents with injury, etc.), the security service, city-hall guards or the police must be informed at once. The instructions of the security service, the city-hall guards or the police must be observed. Stay calm!

Behaviour in case of evacuation

If the LB Premises must be partially or entirely evacuated, the instructions of the city-hall guards, the Organiser, the security service and the executive must be observed. Stay calm!

Cleaning

The LB Premises are cleaned after the end of the event. During the event, only absolutely necessary cleaning work will be performed for logistical reasons. The Organiser therefore asks you not to produce any unnecessary waste.

Lighting

Lighting - including safety lighting - is only turned off when the visitors have left the LB Premises.

Photo, film, video and sound recordings

By purchasing a ticket or an access authorisation of any kind, and the resulting access to the ball premises, the ticket holder grants the broadcasting TV/radio stations and any present photographers the right to evaluate and publish the recordings taken of them without compensation and without any restrictions in time and location, and using any technical methods. Furthermore, everyone with access to the LB Premises grants the association LIFE+ the right to use these recordings free of charge for any purposes - including for advertising.

Everyone who enters the LB Premises takes note of the real-time surveillance on the LB Premises (CCTV), which takes place for reasons of safety. The corresponding marking for the real-time supervision can be found by every entrance to the LB Premises.

Liability

By purchasing the ticket and entering the event area, these house and venue rules are deemed accepted. The originator shall be liable for any property damage and injury caused due to non-observation of these house and venue rules, and shall hold the Organiser harmless towards any third parties, but in particular towards the owner of the event area.

Everyone who enters the LB Premises takes note that they are present there at their own risk. The Organiser shall not take any liability for accidents and/or other damage that exceeds the statutory provisions.

The Organiser does not assume any liability for lost property; this shall also apply to theft.

Expulsion

The Organiser reserves the right to demand that people who violate the House Rules or who give any specific indications

of expected violations show their ID to have their personal data recorded, and to ban them from entering, as well as to pass their details on to the security authorities. Purchased entrance bracelets will not be refunded.

Visitors shall be liable for any damage caused by them, in particular to rooms, facilities and artwork of the event location, according to the provisions under civil law. The Organiser shall not take any liability for accidents concerning the visitors to the LB Premises that exceeds the statutory provisions.

People who violate these House Rules may be banned from the LB Premises, notwithstanding any further legal steps and without any claims to refunds.

Actions relevant under criminal law shall always be reported.

Legal commitment

Violation or non-observance of the action and omission obligations imposed by these House Rules shall be punishable in accordance with Section 32 para. 3 of the Viennese event act (Wiener Veranstaltungsgesetz), LGBl no. 12/1971, as amended.

People younger than 18 are not allowed to enter the ball premises.
Apart from this, the Viennese youth protection act (Wiener Jugenschutzgesetz)

2002, LGBl 17/2002, as amended, shall apply. Vienna, January 2019
